- ★ Earn your ASN in as few as 2 years
- ⋆ Open to non-nurses seeking a pre-licensure program to qualify for the NCLEX-RN and become a Registered Nurse (RN).
- * Hybrid ASN Bridge Option available for CVTs, RTs, LPNs, Military Medics, or Paramedics seeking to become RNs.
- Ideal for individuals interested in online learning or who are located too far from campus to attend an in-person program.
- All didactic coursework is completed online with 24/7 access.
- ★ Clinical rotations will be hosted at partner facilities.
- * Science and general education courses start every two months, and core nursing courses start in January, May, and September!

Hybrid ASN Program Admissions Criteria

- High school diploma/GED or equivalent and/or official transcripts from previous college institutions
- Criminal background & drug check
- Achieve a minimum composite score of 66 on the most current version of the Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) test and a college grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 or higher
 - ➤ TEAS score must be from within three years of anticipated date of enrollment



Additional Admissions Criteria for the Hybrid ASN Bridge Option

- Completion of a CVT, RT, LPN, Military Medic, or Paramedic program
- An active, unrestricted license to practice as a CVT, RT, LPN, Military Medic, or Paramedic

Hybrid ASN Program Content

Herzing University's hybrid ASN Program focuses on patient-centered care, teamwork and collaboration, evidence-based practice, safety, quality improvement and informatics.

This option emphasizes on the use of innovative technologies and preparation for assuming leadership roles.

A minimum of 72 semester credit hours is required for graduation.

For the Bridge Option: CVT, RT, LPN, Military Medic, or Paramedics will transfer in 13 credits toward your ASN!! Your transcripts can be evaluated for additional possible transfer credits.
