

How To Apply

OpusVi and NAU have worked hard to make the application process for this program as easy as possible.

Applicants must fulfill certain requirements for admission:

• Have a bachelor's degree: Applicants must have earned a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale for their bachelor's degree to be considered for regular admission. Students holding a cumulative GPA below 3.0 may be considered for conditional admission with a recommendation and rationale from the admitting academic program.

• GRE/GMAT scores may be waived for students with 3 years of demonstrated work experience or with an undergraduate GPA of 3.25 or higher in any major. The admissions committee may evaluate applicants on a case-by-case basis to determine if an entrance exam will be required for admission.

• Submit an online application including all required components:

- Two essays and a response to one of two short-answer questions
- Two references
- Résumé
- Official transcripts from all previously attended undergraduate and graduate institutions (for our admissions process, we accept unofficial transcripts; students will have to provide official transcripts to the Graduate College)
- An admissions interview


